

Lace up your running shoes and join Barnesville School of Arts & Sciences for their first Color Dash on Saturday, November 8, 2014. Check in starts at 8:30am and the race begins at 10 am and will be held on Barnesville's campus in the beautiful Agricultural Reserve of Montgomery County. Spend time outdoors with family and friends as you run or walk through "clouds" of colored powder. After the race, join everyone for a final color throw extravaganza.

The Color Dash is a community-building event with a focus on family time and living and modeling a healthy lifestyle. The run is less about time and more about fun, so walkers, beginning and seasoned runners are welcome. Any funds raised by the Color Dash will support Barnesville's educational program.

The course is a 1.5 mile loop on the 50-acre campus of the Barnesville School and will traverse through fields, up and down minor hills, and across some gravel.

Adult registration (15 and up) is \$25 per person; families are \$75 for two adults and up to four children in the same family. Long-sleeve white t-shirts are included in the registration fee if registration is received by October 27, 2015.
